The Equality Bill: Progress or Missed Opportunity?

The Government pledged to introduce a Single Equality Bill when it scrapped the separate equality commissions and replaced them with the Equality and Human Rights Commission. The current bill (if and when it becomes law) will replace all existing equality legislation: so its implications are very far reaching. The question is will it really improve the existing situation or will it weaken it?
